Come and see

In today's gospel, John the Baptist proclaims that Jesus is the Lamb of God, the one who takes away our sins, the Promised One of God. When the two disciples run up to Jesus, he asked them, "What are you looking for?" I believe Jesus asks the same question of you and me. How do we answer him? Maybe we can't answer that question, unless we face a deeper question: what is God asking of me? Am I truly letting that question shape me? Are you and I ready, like Samuel, to say: "Speak Lord, for your servant is listening"? Can we accept God's invitation to discipleship, to love and serve God?

Today is World Day of Migrants and Refugees, and we are invited to "come and see" the faithful and courageous works of so many volunteers, organizations, and parishes serving migrants and refugees. As strong advocates with a commitment to care for others, these "disciples" put the gospel into action. They show us—and those they serve—the working hands, feet, and heart of our merciful and loving Messiah. Like Samuel, John, and the first disciples, will you and I "come and see," trusting in the Lord's love and saving power that is given to us and through us for others?
